Blanca Ortiga Shifter!

Set somewhere on the contact point between sculpture and performance, *Shifter!* is a research and creation project focused on the detour, where sculptural situations and action are rticulated in performance environments.



Ander Perez Puelles Ágil y un placaje

Both the Ágil y un placaje project and a large part of its process revolves around the movement and qualities of recording from the game itself as a temporary invalidator of reality. During this stage of the process, attention will focus on the construction of recording tools.



Macarena Recuerda Shepherd Cosa. Intervenir un cuerpo

Cosa is a research project about the intervened body. It is a choreographic laboratory which aims to research how different materials and objects can affect the interpreter's body generating multiple readings.

Laida Lertxundi


8 Encounters

Oscar Gómez Mata Catálogo de derivas



Shifter

Blanca Ortiga presents Shifter!, a project at the meeting point between sculpture and performativity.

Shifter! (US term referring to the gear lever in manual transmission) works with the specific qualities of each material and body as a form of research, to focus on deviation, where sculptural situations and action are articulated in performative environments.

"Resistance, the tension between flexibility and mass, inertia, the effort a body can support, or material fatique prior to breakage, are understood as living forces whose encounters are capable of activating performativity in their materiality", as explained by the creator.

Blanca Ortiga has undertaken Shifter! under Babestu, the Azkuna Zentroa contemporary creation support programme.

BLANCA ORTIGA. (Hornos de Moncalvillo, 1984) is an artist and contemporary art researcher whose practice is located at the contact point between sculpture and performativity. She has presented her work individually and collectively at Matadero (Madrid, 2022), Festival Actual (La Rioja, 2022), Instar International Festival (Cuba, 2021), Tetuán Modern Art Museum (Morocco, 2019), Galería Jorge Alcolea (Madrid, 2018), AFO Architekturforum Oberösterreich (Austria, 2017), Montehermoso Cultural Centre (Gasteiz, 2016) and Teatros del Canal (Madrid, 2015), among others.
